THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO.2) ORDER 1982

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION in pursuance of its powers under Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946 hereby orders:-

1. In the First Schedule to the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1978(a) as amended, the entry relating to Animals and other mammals shall be deleted, and the following entry shall be inserted:-

"Live animals other than cats, dogs, donkeys, fish, goats, guinea pigs, hamsters, horses, pigs, poultry (domestic fowls, ducks, geese, guinea fowls and turkeys), rabbits, racing pigeons and sheep."

2. This Order may be cited as The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) (Amendment No.2) Order, 1982, and shall come into force on the fifteenth day of June, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Amendment Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The effect of this Amendment Order is to add fish, poultry and racing pigeons to the list of live animals that may be imported without the authority of an Import Licence issued by the Board of Administration, when consigned from the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man.

It is to be noted that an Import Licence may be required from the States Committee for Agriculture for the importation of donkeys, goats, horses, pigs, poultry or sheep.
