THE PROHIBITED AND ONE-WAY STREETS (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1996

Made 15th July, 1996  
Coming into force 15th July, 1996

THE STATES TRAFFIC COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 3A(1) of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended(a), hereby orders:-

Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.

1. In Part I of Schedule 2 to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended, the following are inserted in the appropriate places-

- (a) "61a. Rocquettes Road West to East";
- (b) "65a. St. Jacques, between the South-East to point immediately to the North-West". North-West of the easternmost entrance to La Collinette Hotel and its junction with Rozel Road

Citation.

2. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Order, 1996.


