THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 27, section 39, section 50 and section 69 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, and by Part II of the Fourth Schedule to that Law, hereby orders:-

Interpretation

1. (1) In these Regulations, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:-

"the Law" means the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978;

"the relevant day" means the 12th day of November, 1984;

and any other expressions have the same meanings as in the Law.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in these Regulations to any enactment or regulations shall be construed as including a reference to that enactment or those regulations, as the case may be, as amended, repealed, replaced or revoked by or under any other enactment or by any other regulations.

(3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law 1948<sup>(b)</sup>, shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

Higher rates of widow's benefit and old age pension payable at reduced rates owing to partial satisfaction of contribution conditions

2. The Schedule to the Social Insurance (Widow's Benefit and Old Age Pensions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978<sup>(c)</sup>, is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the First Schedule to these Regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Higher rates of sickness benefit and invalidity benefit payable at reduced rates owing to partial satisfaction of contribution conditions

3. (1) The Second Schedule to the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended<sup>(d)</sup>, is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the second Schedule to these Regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

(2) The Third Schedule to the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended<sup>(d)</sup>, is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Third Schedule to these Regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Higher rates of unemployment benefit payable at reduced rates owing to partial satisfaction of contribution conditions and amendments to the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978

4. (1) Regulation 12 of the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended<sup>(d)</sup>, is hereby amended as follows:-

- (a) in paragraph (1) thereof the words "the next two following paragraphs" are repealed and the words "paragraphs (2), (3) and (5) of this Regulation" are substituted therefor;
- (b) in paragraph (2) thereof the words "unemployment and sickness benefit, or increase of any such benefit", where they twice occur, are repealed respectively and the words "sickness benefit, or increase of such benefit" are substituted therefor;
- (c) immediately after paragraph (4) thereof there is inserted the following additional paragraph numbered "(5)" -

"(5) Where the full weekly rate of unemployment benefit, or increase of such benefit for an adult dependant, under the Ordinance specified in the Fifth Schedule to these Regulations is at one of the rates set out at the head of columns (2) and (3) of that Schedule then unemployment benefit or increase of such benefit for an adult dependant, shall be payable at the reduced rate specified in the appropriate column of that Schedule which corresponds with the number of reckonable contributions paid or credited in the relevant contribution year as shown in column (1) of that Schedule."

(2) Immediately after the Fourth Schedule to the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended (d), there is hereby inserted the additional Schedule entitled "Fifth Schedule" set out in the Fourth Schedule to these Regulations.

Higher rates of maternity allowance payable at reduced rates owing to partial satisfaction of contribution conditions

5. The First Schedule to the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended (e), is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Fifth Schedule to these Regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Transitional provisions regarding the payment of the increased amount of maternity grant

6. Where a woman has become entitled to a maternity grant (whether payment has been made or not) before the relevant day and her confinement occurs on or after that day, or, as the case may be, her pregnancy is otherwise terminated on or after that day, she shall be entitled to a maternity grant at the rate specified in Part III of the Schedule to the Social Insurance (Rates of Benefits, etc.) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1984<sup>(f)</sup>.

Higher amounts of death grant payable at reduced amounts owing to partial satisfaction of contribution conditions

7. The Second Schedule to the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended<sup>(g)</sup>, is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Sixth Schedule to these Regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Higher rates of increase of industrial disablement benefit under section 50 of the Law where constant attendance is required

8. The Second Schedule to the Social Insurance (Industrial Injuries Benefits) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978<sup>(h)</sup>, is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Seventh Schedule to these Regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Amendments to Social Insurance (Benefits) (Transitional Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978

9. The Social Insurance (Benefits) (Transitional Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended<sup>(i)</sup>, are hereby further amended as follows:-

- (a) in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (2) of Regulation 19 thereof, the words "eleven pounds and twenty pence" are hereby repealed and the words "twelve pounds" are substituted therefor;
- (b) in sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (2) of Regulation 19 thereof, the words "seventeen pounds and twenty pence" are hereby repealed and the words "eighteen pounds and forty pence" are substituted therefor.

Amendments to Social Insurance (Benefits) (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978

10. In paragraph (2) of Regulation 28 and in Regulation 29 of the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended (j), the words "four pounds and seventy five pence" are hereby repealed respectively and the words "five pounds" are substituted therefor.

Amendment to Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978

11. Sub-paragraph (f) of paragraph (1) of Regulation 6 of the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended (k), shall have effect, on or after the 1st day of January, 1985, as if for the words "fifteen pounds and fifty pence" therein there were substituted the words "sixteen pounds".

Repeal

12. The Social Insurance (Increase of Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1983<sup>(l)</sup>, are hereby repealed.

Extent

13. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.


