The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying)
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1985

Made 12th November 1985

Coming into operation 12th November 1985

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by paragraph (1) of Article 66 of the Air Navigation Order, 1980(a), as amended and applied to Guernsey by the Air Navigation (Guernsey) Order, 1981(b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

1. These regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1985, and shall come into force on the 12th day of November, nineteen hundred and eighty-five.
2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying)(Guernsey) Regulations 1971(c) are hereby revoked.
3. (1) An aircraft shall not fly at a height of less than 2,000 feet above ground level over the area bounded by a circle of three nautical miles radius having its centre at the premises known as "Clos de Dixcart" in the Island of Sark: Provided that nothing in this regulation shall prohibit flight over the said area at a height of less than 2,000 feet above ground level in conformity with permission granted by or on behalf of the States Board of Administration.

(2) For the purpose of this regulation, the position of the said Clos de Dixcart shall be deemed to be 49° 25'50"., 02° 21'40" W.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations re-enact the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying)(Guernsey) Regulations 1971 and restricts the height at which aircraft may fly over the Island of Sark without the permission of the States Board of Administration.
