THE STATES ADVISORY AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 5(6), 8(2), 19(2) and 40 of the Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1986 (a), hereby makes the following Regulations -

Fee for registration and renewal of registration

1. The prescribed fee payable under section 5(6) of the Law on an application for registration, and under section 7(5) of the Law on a renewal application, is ~~£50.~~ £75 (1992/29)

Fee for alteration of registered particulars

2. The fee payable under section 5(6) of the Law for the alteration of registered particulars is £20.

Fee for certified copy

3. The fee payable under section 8(2) of the Law for a certified copy of the particulars contained in any entry made in the register is

- (a) £5; and
- (b) 25 pence for each page of the copy.

Maximum fee for subject access

4. The maximum fee payable by an individual on making a request under section 19 of the Law to be supplied with information concerning any data held about him is £10 in respect of each request made by him.

Interpretation

5. In these Regulations "the Law" means the Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1986 and other expressions have the meanings assigned to them by the Law.

Revocation

6. The Data Protection (Fees) Regulations, 1987 (b) are revoked.

7. These Regulations may be cited as the Data Protection (Fees) Regulations, 1989.

Commencement

8. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1989.
