THE IMPORT DUTIES (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (NO. 66) ORDER, 1974

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by section two of the Import Duties Act (Bailiwick of Guernsey) 1932, as amended, and in accordance with the States Resolution of 29 May, 1974, hereby orders:-

1. The Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 64) Order, 1973, as amended (a) is hereby further amended as follows:-

the rates of duty in respect of tariff sub-headings O6.01A.IIa), A.IIb) and A.III shown in the third column of the Second Schedule thereto prefixed by the letter "M" are revoked and the word "Free" is substituted therefor.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

- (1) This Order may be cited as The Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 66) Order, 1974.
- (2) This Order shall come into operation on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy-four.

This Order, which comes into operation on 1 July, 1974, removes the import duty on dormant flower bulbs, corms, rhizomes, tubers and tuberous roots which are in free circulation in the European Economic Community.
