THE BOVINE SEMEN (IMPORTATION) ORDER, 1985

THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR AGRICULTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 2A of The Bovine Semen and Artificial Insemination Ordinance, 1957, as amended (a), hereby orders:-

1. The Committee hereby specifies as the breeds of bovines from which the Committee may import semen or cause semen to be imported, under section 2A of The Bovine Semen and Artificial Insemination Ordinance, 1957, as amended, the following breeds of bovines:

Aberdeen Angus;
Charollais;
Hereford;
Limousin.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (b) applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. The Bovine Semen (Importation of Charollais Semen) Order, 1972 (c), is hereby repealed.
4. This Order may be cited as The Bovine Semen (Importation) Order, 1985.
5. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of December, 1985.
