THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 2A(a) and 2B of the Motor Taxation and Licensing (Guernsey) Law, 1987, as amended ⁽¹⁾, hereby orders:-

Amendment of 1995 Ordinance

1. The Driving Licences (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1995, as amended ⁽²⁾, is further amended by substituting for the entry in Schedule 4 relating to the vehicles able to be driven under a category P (moped) driving licence, the following entry:

“Category P – Moped

Any two-wheeled or three-wheeled vehicle which is powered by:

- a) *an internal combustion engine having a cylinder capacity not exceeding 50 cubic centimetres, or*
- b) *an electrical engine having a maximum continuous rated power not exceeding 4kW”.*

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Driving Licences (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2006.


Commencement

The Driving Licences (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2006

Explanatory Note

Category P (moped) licences currently entitle the holder to drive vehicles that are powered by internal combustion engines only.

These regulations extend the type of vehicles covered under P licences beyond those powered by internal combustion engines, to include motorcycles powered by electricity.
