THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 9 and 12 of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, as amended, and as modified by the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescribed Appliances) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1977<sup>(a)</sup>, hereby orders:-

Amendments to the Regulations of 1977

1. The Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescribed Appliances) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1977, as amended,<sup>(b)</sup> are hereby further amended as follows:-

(a) in Regulation 8 thereof paragraphs (2) and (3) are repealed and the following paragraphs are substituted therefor -

" (2) Subject to the provisions of the next following paragraph, an approved appliance supplier of any class shall be paid out of the Fund in respect of any appliance supplied by him under the Law the sum of the following amounts, that is to say:-

(a) as regards an approved appliance supplier of any class an amount equal to the amount of the basic price of the appliance;

(b) as regards any class of approved appliance supplier who is -

(i) a dentist 11.5 per centum of that amount;

(ii) a medical practitioner 11.5 per centum of that amount;

(iii) a pharmacist 19.5 per centum of that amount;

(iv) any other class of approved appliance supplier not being a dentist, medical practitioner or pharmacist 19.5 per centum of that amount;"

(c) as regards an approved appliance supplier of any class a dispensing fee of 23 pence;

(d) as regards an approved appliance supplier of any class where the appliance is an appliance of any of the descriptions specified in Part I or Part II of the First Schedule to these Regulations a container allowance of 4.5 pence.

(3) The amount payable to an approved appliance supplier of any class under paragraph (2) of this Regulation shall be reduced -

(a) as respects an appliance of any of the descriptions specified in Part I or Part II of the First Schedule to these Regulations by the percentage amount set out in the Fourth Schedule thereto opposite the amounts within the scale corresponding to the amount of the basic price of the prescribed appliances supplied set out in the first column of that Fourth Schedule;

(b) in respect of any prescribed appliance by an amount equal to the amount of any prescription charge or appliance charge received or recoverable by him in respect of that appliance.";

(b) immediately after the Third Schedule thereto there is inserted the additional Schedule entitled "FOURTH SCHEDULE" set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

### Repeal

2. The Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescribed Appliances) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1982<sup>(c)</sup>, are hereby repealed.

Extent

3. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescribed Appliances) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1986.


Collective Title
