THE IMMIGRATION (PARTICULARS OF PASSENGERS AND CREW)(AMENDMENT)(GUERNSEY)
ORDER 1980

Made 23 September 1980

Coming into Operation 1 October 1980

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by paragraph 27(2) of Schedule 2 of the Immigration Act 1971, as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 1972 (a), I hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Particulars of Passengers and Crew)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Order 1980 and shall come into force on 1st October 1980.
2. For the form set out in the Schedule to the Immigration (Particulars of Passengers and Crew)(Guernsey) Order 1972 (b) there shall be substituted the form set out in the Schedule to this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Article 3 of the Immigration (Particulars of Passengers and Crew)(Guernsey) Order 1972 requires (inter alia) the master of a ship arriving in the Bailiwick from or after calling at a place outside the common travel area to furnish to an immigration officer within 12 hours a return containing particulars of all crew members, the form of return being prescribed in the Schedule to the Order. This Order, as from 1st October, 1980 substitutes a new form recommended for this purpose by the United Nations Inter-Governmental Maritime Consultative Organisation.
