

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY)

(AMENDMENT No. 3) ORDER 1982

The Board of Administration in pursuance of its powers under Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law 1946 hereby orders:-

1. In the First Schedule to the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1978 (a) as amended, the entry relating to Wireless telegraphy apparatus shall be deleted and the following entry shall be inserted:-

"Wireless telegraphy apparatus designed or adapted for the purpose of transmitting spoken messages in the frequency band 26.1 MHz to 29.7 MHz or 88 MHz to 108 MHz, other than apparatus which is designed or adapted for the purpose of transmitting spoken messages, on the frequency channels specified in paragraph 1.3 of Home Office Specification MPT 1320 and which complies with the requirements specified in Regulations 3 and 4 of, and the Schedule to, the Wireless Telegraphy (Control of Interference from Citizen's Band Radio Apparatus) Regulations 1982."

2. The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Order, 1982 (b) is hereby revoked.
3. This Order may be cited as The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1982, and shall come into force on the twenty fifth day of August, nineteen hundred and eighty two.
