The Import of Pigeons Order, 1984

Made 6th AUGUST 1984

Coming into Operation 13th AUGUST 1984

The States Committee for Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 3 (ii) of the Live Poultry Importation Ordinance, 1950, as amended (a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders -

1. The importation into this Island of any consignment of pigeons is hereby prohibited unless that consignment is accompanied by a certificate, issued by a person of such description as the States Committee for Agriculture may from time to time approve in that regard, stating that each bird in that consignment has been vaccinated against the disease known as Paramyxovirus.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (b), shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Import of Pigeons Order, 1984.
4. This Order shall come into force on the THIRTEENTH day of AUGUST, 1984.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order prohibits the importation of pigeons unless they are certified as having been vaccinated against Paramyxovirus (a form of Newcastle disease).
