The Milk (Retail Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1991

THE STATES AGRICULTURAL AND MILK MARKETING BOARD, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Resolution of the States dated 28th January, 1987 made under section 3 of the Milk and Milk Products (Guernsey) Law of 1955, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:-

1. The price to be charged on a sale by retail of milk shall be as follows:-

During the period commencing on the seventh day of July, nineteen hundred and ninety-one and ending on the sixth day of July, nineteen hundred and ninety-two, at the rates of 76p per litre, and 39p per half-litre for full cream and low fat milk; 38p per half-litre for skimmed milk; Provided that the provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to any milk supplied to a beneficiary under any scheme for the time being in force provided by the States for the supply of milk whether free of cost or at a reduced price.

2. The Milk (Retail Prices) (No. 2) (Guernsey) Order 1990 is hereby revoked.

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

4. This Order may be cited as the Milk (Retail Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1991 and shall come into force on the seventh day of July, nineteen hundred and ninety-one.
