THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections twenty-nine, thirty, thirty-three and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended(a), hereby orders:

New Schedule
to Order
of 1969.

1. The Schedule to the Post Office (Postal Order) Order, 1969, as amended(b), is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Order is hereby substituted therefor.

Repeal.

2. The Post Office (Postal Order) (Amendment) Order, 1977(c), is hereby repealed.

Citation.

3. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Postal Order) (Amendment) Order, 1979.

Commencement.

4. This Order shall come into force on the second day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine.
