


GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT No 23

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL)
(GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT No 2) ORDER 1993

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of its powers under Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control)(Guernsey) Law 1946, hereby orders:-

1. In Schedule 1 to The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1990, as amended (a), entry 3(a) shall be deleted, and entries 3(b) to 3(e) shall be relettered 3(a) to 3(d) respectively.
2. This Order may be cited as The Import and Export of Goods (Control)(Guernsey)(Amendment No 2) Order 1993, and shall come into force on the 29th September 1993.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Amendment Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The effect of the Amendment Order is to prohibit, except under Licence, the importation from the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey and the Isle of Man of cartridges for smooth-bore guns.

While this Amendment Order prohibits except under Licence the importation of such cartridges, an Open General Import Licence for Firearms and ammunition exists which permits the importation of ammunition by a Local resident, provided the importer produces to a Customs Officer of the States of Guernsey the appropriate certificate or permit under The Firearms (Guernsey) Law 1983.
