THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL)(GUERNSEY) ORDER 1978

AMENDMENT NO.1 TO THE OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE OF 1984

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in exercise of its powers under Section 3 of the Import and Export of Goods (Control)(Guernsey) Order 1978 (a) hereby modifies the Open General Import Licence granted by the said Board upon the 27th March 1984 (b) as follows:-

1. Schedule 1 shall be amended as follows:-

(e) In entry No.72, "*" shall be inserted after "Poland" in the fourth column.

(f) In entry Nos. 84 and 92, "*" shall be inserted after "Taiwan" in the fourth column.

(g) In entry No. 86, "*" shall be inserted after "Taiwan" and "ST" shall be replaced by "Albania; Cambodia; China*; Czechoslovakia; German Democratic Republic and Berlin (East); Hungary; Korea (North); Laos; Mongolia; Poland; Romania; the Soviet Union; Vietnam" in the fourth column; "Bulgaria" shall be deleted from the fifth column.

(h) In entry No. 88, "Philippines" shall be inserted in the fourth column.

(i) In entry No. 101, "Yugoslavia" shall be inserted in the fourth column.

(j) In entry No. 133, "*" shall be inserted after "China" in the fourth column.

(k) Entry No. 210 shall be deleted.

(1) In entry No. 213, in the description of goods in the second column, item (iii), the words "and component parts of any such ammunition" shall be deleted.

Blooms, billets, slabs and sheet bars, of high carbon steel or of alloy steel, other than forged or of high speed alloy steel (ECSC); wire rod of high carbon steel, not further worked than hot-rolled or extruded (ECSC); sheets and plates, of high carbon steel, not further worked than cold-rolled, of a thickness of 3mm or more (ECSC); bars and rods (including wire rod), hollow mining drill steel and angles, shapes and sections, of alloy steel, not further worked than hot-rolled or extruded (ECSC); "electrical" sheets and plates, of alloy steel, other than those with a watt-loss, regardless of thickness, of 0.75 watt or less (ECSC); sheets and plates, of alloy steel, not further worked than hot-rolled, other than sheets and plates of high speed alloy steel and of a thickness of 3mm or more and other than "electrical" sheets and plates (ECSC);

sheets and plates, of alloy steel, not further worked than cold-rolled, other than sheets and plates of high speed alloy steel and of a thickness of less than 3mm and other than "electrical" sheets and plates (ECSC).
