THE IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW 1946  
THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER 1978  
AMENDMENT NO 3 TO THE OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE OF 1982

The Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Section 3 of the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order 1978 (a) hereby further modifies the Open General Import Licence granted by the said Board upon the 16th February 1982 (b) as follows:-

1) Article 1 (a) shall be amended as follows:-

- (a) In the definition of "ACP Area" "Belize," shall be inserted after "Barbados,". ✓
- (b) In the definition of "OCT Area" "Belize," shall be deleted. ✓
- (c) In the definition of "Synthetic Textile Area" "Zimbabwe" shall be deleted. ✓

2) In Article 2 for "Schedule 1,2 or 3" there shall be substituted "Schedule 1,2,3 or 4". ✓

3) In the proviso to Article 3, for the words "Schedule 2 hereto." there shall be substituted the words "Schedule 2 or 3 hereto." ✓

4) In Article 4:-

(a) After paragraph (a) there shall be inserted as paragraph (b) the following paragraph:-

"(b) goods also comprised in any entry in column 2 of Schedule 3 hereto which are not permitted to be imported by virtue of (c) of Article 4A; or"

(b) paragraph "(b)" shall be renumbered as paragraph "(c)".

5) After Article 4 there shall be inserted the following further Article,

"4A. Goods comprised in any entry in Column 2 of Schedule 3 may be imported into Guernsey under the authority of this Licence unless they are:-

- (a) goods also comprised in any entry in column 2 of Schedule 1 hereto which are not permitted to be imported by virtue of (a) to (c) of Article 3; or

(b) goods also comprised in any entry in column 2 of Schedule 2 hereto which are not permitted to be imported by virtue of

(c) of Article 4; or

(c) goods originating in the Soviet Union which are not in free circulation in the European Economic Community."

6) In Article 5, for "Schedule 4" there shall be substituted "Schedule 5".

7) Schedule 1 shall be amended as follows:-

(a) In Entry No. 182, "China; Romania" shall be inserted in the fifth column.

(b) The following Entry shall be inserted:-

(c) In Entry No. 204, "China" shall be inserted in the fifth column.

(d) In Entry No. 204A, "China" shall be inserted in the fourth column.

(e) In Entry Nos. 40, 41, 42 and 162, "Zimbabwe" shall be deleted from the fifth column.

(f) In Entry No. 78, "the Republic of Korea" shall be inserted in the fourth column.

(g) In Entry No. 4, "Bananas, fresh or dried" shall be deleted from the second column and "Bananas, fresh" shall be inserted in its place.

(h) In Entry Nos. 89, 114, and 147, "China" shall be deleted from the fifth column.

(i) In Entry No. 78, "Singapore" shall be inserted in the fourth column.

(j) In Entry Nos. 76 and 81, "China" shall be deleted from the fifth column.

- (k) In Entry No. 33, "Turkey" shall be inserted in the fourth column.
- (l) In Entry No. 77, "Philippines" shall be inserted in the fourth column.
- (m) In Entry Nos. 110 and 130, "China" shall be deleted from the fifth column.
- (n) In Entry Nos. 90 and 115, "China" shall be inserted in the fourth column.
- (o) In Entry No. 126, "Sri Lanka" shall be inserted in the fourth column.
- (p) In Entry No. 163, "\*" shall be inserted after "German Democratic Republic and Berlin (East)" in the fourth column.
- (q) In Entry Nos. 90 and 115, "Singapore" shall be inserted in the fourth column.

8) Schedule 2 shall be amended as follows:-

(a) The following Entry shall be inserted:-

"1127A	ex 62.02	Table linen, of cotton, of man-made textile fibres, of wool or of fine animal hair; toilet linen and kitchen linen, of cotton, of man-made textile fibres, of wool or of fine animal hair, <u>other than articles of terry towelling and similar terry fabrics of cotton.</u>	39 Malaysia; Philippines; Singapore; Thailand "

- (b) In Entry No. 1128, "Malaysia; Philippines; Singapore and Thailand" shall be inserted in the fourth column.
- (c) In Entry No. 1025, "Turkey" shall be deleted from the fourth column.
- (d) In Entry Nos. 1085 and 1108, "China" shall be deleted from the fourth column.
- (e) Entry Nos. 1070, 1075, 1084, 1103, 1107, 1117, and 1124 shall be deleted.

9) After Schedule 2 there shall be inserted the Schedule hereto.

- 10) Schedule 3 shall be renumbered Schedule 4, the entries therein renumbered 3001 to 3004 respectively and the pages renumbered 43 and 44 respectively.

*(Goods which are to be imported)*  
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11) In Schedule 4, as renumbered, the Description of Goods in Entry No. 3003 shall be deleted and the following description shall be substituted therefor:-

*Do these covered by 1982/22 they also imported, 2 by 1982/22 they also*

"Wireless telegraphy apparatus designed or adapted for the purpose of transmitting spoken messages in the frequency band 26.1 MHz to 29.7 MHz or 88 MHz to 108 MHz, other than apparatus which is designed or adapted for the purpose of transmitting spoken messages, on the frequency channels specified in paragraph 1.3 of Home Office Specification MPT 1320 and which complies with the requirements specified in Regulations 3 and 4 of, and the Schedule to, the Wireless Telegraphy (Control of Interference from Citizen's Band Radio Apparatus) Regulations 1982."

12) Schedule 4 shall be renumbered Schedule 5 and the pages renumbered 45 to 59 respectively.

13) This amendment shall come into operation on the twentyfifth day of August nineteen hundred and eighty-two.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the amendment to the Open General Import Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The effect of this Amendment is to update the Licence in line with current United Kingdom governmental policy and includes the introduction of restrictions on the importation of certain goods from the Soviet Union and an amended description in the entry relating to Citizens Band Radio Apparatus.
