The Milk (Retail Prices) (Guernsey) Order (No. 2), 1988

THE STATES AGRICULTURAL AND MILK MARKETING BOARD, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Resolution of the States dated 28th January, 1987 made under section 3 of the Milk and Milk Products (Guernsey) Law of 1955, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:-

1. The price to be charged on a sale by retail of milk shall be as follows:-

During the period commencing on the fourth day of September, nineteen hundred and eighty-eight and ending on the thirtieth day of September, nineteen hundred and eighty-nine, at the rates of 58p per litre, and 31p per half-litre; Provided that the provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to any milk supplied to a beneficiary under any scheme for the time being in force provided by the States for the supply of milk whether free of cost or at a reduced price.

2. The Milk (Retail Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1988 is hereby revoked.

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

4. This Order may be cited as the Milk (Retail Prices) (Guernsey) Order (No. 2), 1988 and shall come into force on the fourth day of September, nineteen hundred and eighty-eight.
