Statutory Instrument 1977 No. 24

The Customs and Excise (General Provisions)(Bailiwick
of Guernsey) Order, 1977

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by section fifteen of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1972 hereby orders:-

1. Subsection (b) of section three of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions)(Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1973 (a) is hereby repealed and the following new subsection (b) is substituted therefor:-

"(b) goods imported from the United Kingdom in respect of which all liability to Community customs duties, levies, import restrictions and other customs procedures has been discharged and which goods are free to circulate in the Community;"

2. This Order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (General Provisions)(Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1977 and shall come into force on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This amendment provides that, w.e.f. 1 July 1977, Customs Entry will only be required for goods imported from the United Kingdom which are not in free circulation in the United Kingdom.
