The Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1989

Made 15 August, 1989
Laid before the States
Coming into operation 1 September, 1989

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 12 of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, as amended^(a), hereby orders:-

Amendment to the Regulations of 1983

1. The Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1983, as amended^(b), are hereby further amended as follows:-

- (a) the Second Schedule thereto is repealed and the Schedule set out in the First Schedule to these Regulations is substituted therefor;
- (b) the Third Schedule thereto is repealed and the Schedule set out in the Second Schedule to these Regulations is substituted therefor.

Extent

2. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1989.


Collective Title

Additional dispensing fees payable in respect of pharmaceutical benefit supplied on a prescription endorsed "URGENT" or "DISPENSED URGENTLY" in accordance with Regulation 3 of these Regulations.

On any day between eleven o'clock in the afternoon of the next previous day and nine o'clock in the forenoon or such earlier time at which the premises of the approved supplier are open for the supply of pharmaceutical benefit	£13.40

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These Regulations further amend the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1983 (as amended), so as to provide for an adjustment to the payments due in respect of the supply of pharmaceutical benefit by different classes of approved suppliers.
