The Social Insurance (Classification)(Amendment)  
(Guernsey) Regulation, 1980

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section one of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of paragraph 8 of the First Schedule to the principal regulations

1. In paragraph 8 in column (A) of Part III of the First Schedule to the Social Insurance (Classification)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, (hereafter in these regulations referred to as "the principal regulations") as amended, for the words "eleven pounds" in sub-paragraph (a) thereof there are hereby substituted the words "thirteen pounds" and for the words "forty-seven pounds and sixty-three pence" in sub-paragraph (b) thereof there are hereby substituted the words "fifty-six pounds and thirty-three pence".

Repeal

2. Regulation one of the Social Insurance (Classification)(Amendment) (No.2)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1979 is hereby repealed.

Citation and collective title

3. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Classification)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1980.

(2) These regulations and the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 to 1979 may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Classification)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 to 1980.

Commencement

4. These regulations shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and eighty-one.
