The Social Insurance (Classification)(Amendment)
(Guernsey) Regulations 1981

Made 6th October, 1981.
Laid before the States
Coming into operation 1st January, 1982.

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section one of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978,^(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of paragraph 8 of the First Schedule to the principal regulations

1. In paragraph 8 in column (A) of Part III of the First Schedule to the Social Insurance (Classification)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1978^(b), (hereafter in these regulations referred to as "the principal regulations") as amended, for the words "thirteen pounds" in sub-paragraph (a) thereof there are hereby substituted the words "fourteen pounds and fifty pence" and for the words "fifty-six pounds and thirty-three pence" in sub-paragraph (b) thereof there are hereby substituted the words "sixty-two pounds and eighty-three pence".

Repeal

2. The Social Insurance (Classification)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1980^(c) are hereby repealed. ✓

Citation and collective title

3. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Classification)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1981

(2) These regulations and the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 to 1979 may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Classification)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 to 1981.

Commencement

4. These regulations shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations further amend the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, so as to provide that an insured person who is employed under a contract of service from which he derives weekly earnings of less than fourteen pounds and fifty pence or monthly earnings of less than sixty-two pounds and eighty-three pence shall be treated as a non-employed person.
