The Weights and Measures (Fees) Regulations, 1997

Made	28th July, 1997
Laid before the States	24th September, 1997
Coming into operation	31st October, 1997

THE STATES BOARD OF INDUSTRY, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 8 (1), (4) and (5) of the Weights and Measures (Guernsey and Alderney) Law, 1991 (a) and in exercise of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations -

1.(1) The Schedule hereto shall have effect for prescribing the fee to be paid in respect of the testing of any item of weighing or measuring equipment to which section 8 of the Law applies with a view to its being passed as fit for use for trade and where necessary stamped.

(2) The appropriate fee shall be payable whether or not the equipment is passed as fit for use for trade and stamped.

2.(1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (b) applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as if they were an enactment.

(2) In these Regulations "the Law" means the Weights and Measures (Guernsey and Alderney) Law, 1991.



3. These Regulations may be cited as the Weights and Measures (Fees) Regulations, 1997.

4. These Regulations shall come into operation on 31st October, 1997.

5. The Weights and Measures (Fees) Regulations, 1991 (c) are hereby revoked, save for prescribing the fees to be charged in respect of a test undertaken prior to the commencement of these Regulations.

A fee based on the fee corresponding with the capacity of the machine tested plus a charge to cover any additional tests at a rate of £25.00 per hour of inspector time.

E. Measuring Instruments for measuring liquid fuel or lubricants, or mixture thereof, each instrument -

A fee based on the above fee corresponding with the type of instrument tested plus a charge to cover any additional tests at a rate of £25.00 per hour of inspector time.

F. Measuring Equipment for measuring liquid fuels in excess of 100 litres dispensed from road tankers -

(1) Meter measuring systems (per meter)	-	£60.00
(2) Dipstick measuring system (per replacement dipstick)	-	£13.00

G. For equipment not specifically described in the categories above, at the rate of £25.00 per hour of inspector time.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the Regulations

These Regulations prescribe the fees to be paid for the testing of weighing or measuring equipment with a view to its being passed as fit for use for trade and stamped. The fees are payable whether or not the equipment is passed.
