The Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment) Regulations, 1994

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 35 and 38 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990, as amended(a), and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. In Regulation 6 of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) Regulations, 1990, as amended(b), after "contraception" insert -

"or immunisation for the purpose of holiday or business travel."


Citation

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations amend the Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) Regulations, 1990, as amended, so as to exempt immunisation for the purposes of holiday or business travel from being a "medicinal purpose" for which pharmaceutical benefit can be supplied.
