

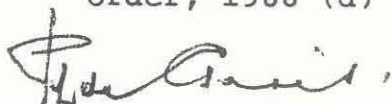
GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT 1990 No.25

Made 30th October 1990
Coming into Force 15th November 1990

The Importation of Feeding Stuffs Order 1990

The States Agricultural and Milk Marketing Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by Section II of The Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952 as amended (a) and now vested in it (b), hereby orders:-

1. The importation into the Island of animal feeding stuffs which contain animal protein (except milk, milk products and dicalcium bone phosphate) is prohibited.
2. The importation into the Island of animal feedingstuffs (including pet foods), which contain bovine offal is prohibited.
3. In article 2 "bovine offal" means the brain, spinal cord, spleen, thymus, tonsils and intestines of a bovine animal which was over six months of age when slaughtered and which has been slaughtered in the United Kingdom.
4. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (c), applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of the enactment.
5. This Order may be cited as the Importation of Feeding Stuffs Order, 1990.
6. This Order shall come into force on 15th November 1990.
7. The Animal and Animal Products (Import and Export) Order, 1988 (d) is hereby repealed.
