**The Social Insurance (Classification) (Amendment)  
Regulations, 1993**

**THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 1 and 116 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended(a), hereby orders:-

**Amendment**

1. Part III of the First Schedule to the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended(b), is hereby amended as follows:-

- (a) in paragraph 8(a) of Column (A) thereof for "£28.50" substitute "29.00";
- (b) in paragraph 8(b) of Column (A) thereof for "£123.50" substitute "£125.67";
- (c) in paragraph 9 of Column (a) thereof for the words "seven and one half per centum of the current lower weekly earnings limit" there is substituted "the product of such percentage as shall for the time being be determined by the States by Ordinance under section 6(2) of the Law and the current lower weekly earnings limit".

**Repeal**

2. The Social Insurance (Classification) (Amendment) Regulations, 1992(c) are repealed.

**Extent**

3. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

**Citation**

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Classification) (Amendment) Regulations, 1993.

**Commencement**

5. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1994.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations further amend the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 so as to provide that an insured person who is employed under a contract of service from which he derives weekly earnings of less than £29.00 or monthly earnings of less than £125.67 shall be treated as a non-employed person. The final provision is of a technical nature relating to the minimum Class 2 contribution.
