The Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations, 2006

THE SOCIAL SECURITY DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 10 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990 as amended¹, section 1 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited Lists) Ordinance, 2004² and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. In the Schedule to the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) Regulations, 2004³, as amended;
 - (a) add the rows set out in Schedule 1 to these Regulations, under the appropriate headings; and
 - (b) delete the rows set out in Schedule 2 to these Regulations.

Extent

2. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Interpretation

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 applies to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

Citation

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations, 2006.
