The Health Service (Physiotherapy Benefit) (Amendment) Regulations, 2005

THE SOCIAL SECURITY DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Part IIIA and section 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990, as amended^(a), and as modified by the Health Service (Physiotherapy Benefit) Ordinance, 1997, as amended^(b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendments

1. In the Schedule to the Health Service (Physiotherapy Benefit) Regulations, 2002^(c), after "domiciliary physiotherapy services" insert "except for domiciliary visits to patients in relation to a diagnosis of Multiple Sclerosis".

Extent

2. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Physiotherapy Benefit) (Amendment) Regulations, 2005.

Commencement

4. These Regulations come into force on 1st day of September 2005.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These Regulations amend the exclusions contained in the Health Service (Physiotherapy Benefit) Regulations, 2002 to allow domiciliary visits to be provide as Physiotherapy Benefit by the physiotherapists employed under the contract with the Guernsey Physiotherapy Group to patients receiving treatment for Multiple Sclerosis.
