

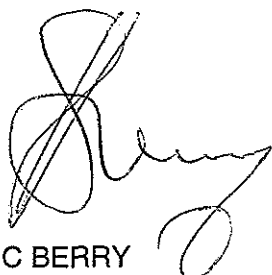
GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT 2000 No. 26

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT No. 2) ORDER 2000

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of its powers under Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control)(Guernsey) Law 1946, hereby orders: -

1. In Schedule 1 to The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order 1990, (a), as amended (b) entry number 5 shall be repealed.
2. This Order may be cited as The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2000, and shall come into force on the 1st January 2001.

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Amendment Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order removes marine anti-fouling paint from Schedule 1 to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order 1990. That Schedule lists goods, which may not be imported from the UK without a licence. Controls on the importation of such paint are now contained in The Control of Poisonous Substances Regulations, 1995.
