
THE IMPORTATION OF FERTILISERS AND FEEDING STUFFS ORDER, 1994

Made	20 December 1994
Laid before the States	1995
Coming into force	20 January 1995

The States Agricultural and Milk Marketing Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 11 of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, as amended (a) and now vested in it (b), hereby orders:

1. The importation into the Island of ruminant feeding stuffs which contain animal protein (except milk, milk products and dicalcium bone phosphate) is prohibited.
2. The importation into the Island of animal feeding stuffs, (including pet foods), which contain bovine offal is prohibited.
3. The importation into Island of fertilisers which contain bovine offal is prohibited.
4. In articles 2 and 3 "bovine offal" means the brain, spinal cord, spleen and tonsils of a bovine animal which was over 6 months of age when slaughtered and the thymus and intestines of any bovine animal, except those under 2 months of age which had not been slaughtered for human consumption.
5. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (c) applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
6. The Order may be cited as the Importation of Fertilisers and Feeding Stuff Order, 1994.
7. This Order shall come into force on 20 January 1995.

8. The Importation of Fertilisers and Feedings Stuffs Order, 1991 (d) is hereby repealed.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

This Order extends the definition of bovine offal to include certain offals taken from all bovine animals other than those under 2 months of age that were not slaughtered for human consumption.
