**The Social Insurance (Classification) (Amendment)  
Regulations, 1990**

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 1 and section 116 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, hereby orders:—

*Amendment*

1. Part III of the First Schedule to the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended<sup>(b)</sup>, is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) in paragraph 8(a) of Column (A) thereof for the words “twenty-three pounds” substitute “£24.50”;

(b) in paragraph 8(b) of Column (A) thereof for the words “ninety-nine pounds and sixty seven pence” substitute “£110.50”.

*Repeal*

2. The Social Insurance (Classification) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1989(c), are repealed.

*Extent*

3. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

*Citation*

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Classification) (Amendment) Regulations, 1990.

*Collective Title*

5. These Regulations and the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 to 1988, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Classification) Regulations, 1978 to 1990.

*Commencement*

6. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1991.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations further amend the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 so as to provide that an insured person who is employed under a contract of service from which he derives weekly earnings of less than £24.50 or monthly earnings of less than £110.50 shall be treated as a non-employed person.
