The Social Insurance (Contributions)(Amendment) (No. 2)
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1988

Made 4th October, 1988
Laid before the States
Coming into operation 1st January, 1989

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 20 and section 104(3) of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended^(a), hereby orders:-

Amendment of Regulation 19 of the principal Regulations

1. Regulation 19 of the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended^(b), (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations") is hereby further amended as follows:-

(a) paragraph (4) is repealed and the following paragraph is substituted therefor -

"(4) Subject to the provisions of the next following paragraph, an employer shall pay to the Authority within the fifteen days next following the expiration of a contribution quarter the amount due for the contributions recorded as being payable on the appropriate contribution schedule for that quarter in accordance with the forgoing provisions of this Regulation, and that amount shall be accompanied by that contribution schedule.";

(b) paragraph (5) is repealed and the following paragraph is substituted therefor -

"(5) Any employer may, and every employer employing more than eighty persons in any employment (which in the case of each and every such person, is an employed contributor's employment) in any month shall pay to the Authority, within the fifteen days next following the expiration of that month, the amount due for the contributions recorded in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this regulation as being payable in respect of the earnings of these persons paid in that month together with a statement in such form as the Authority shall determine and containing such particulars as the Authority shall direct."

Amendment of the Seventh Schedule to the principal Regulations

2. The Seventh Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these Regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Repeal

3. Regulation 2 of the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1987^(c) and Regulation 5 of the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulation, 1988^(d), are hereby repealed.

Extent

4. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) (No.2) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1988.

Collective title

6. These Regulations, the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1988 and the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 to 1987, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 to 1988.

Commencement

7. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1989.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These Regulations amend the provisions of Regulation 19 so as to bring them into correspondence with the provisions of Section 104(1A) of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, and specify the lower weekly earnings limit and the lower monthly earnings limit as respects the contribution year commencing on 1 January, 1989.
