**THE STATES PROCEDURES AND CONSTITUTION COMMITTEE**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 34 (2) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>(a)</sup> as amended<sup>(b)</sup>, hereby makes the following rules:-

**Public Inspection of Electoral Roll**

1. All sections of the Electoral Roll shall be available for inspection on each weekday (other than a Public Holiday or Saturday) in the month of January in each year at

- (i) Sir Charles Frossard House
- (ii) The Greffe, Royal Court House
- (iii) The Guille-Allès Library

during their normal hours of business.

2. The section of the Electoral Roll in respect of each District shall be published for inspection on each weekday (other than a Public Holiday or Saturday) in the month of January in each year by the Constables of the parishes at the Douzaine Rooms or Constables' Offices during their normal hours of business and at such other places and times as shall be agreed with the said Constables.

**Citation**

3. These rules may be cited as The Electoral Roll (Public Inspection) Rules, 2003.

**Commencement**

4. These rules shall come into operation on 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2004.
