THE STATES HOME DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 25(6) of the Regulation of Investigatory Powers (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2003¹ (“the Law”), hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Regulation of Investigatory Powers (Applicable Public Authorities) Regulations, 2004, and shall come into force on 14th June, 2004.

Amendments to Schedule 1

2. (1) Schedule 1 to the Law shall be amended as follows.

(2) After paragraph (4), substitute the following -

“5. The Guernsey Financial Services Commission.


6. The Treasury and Resources Department.

7. The Social Security Department.

9. The Commerce and Employment Department.
10. The Home Department.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend Schedule 1 to the Regulation of Investigatory Powers (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2003 by modifying the names of the applicable public authorities specified in the Schedule to reflect the changes introduced by the Machinery of Government (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 2003.
