## The Health Service (Medical Appliances) (Amendment) Regulations, 2000

**THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 15, 16, 18 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, hereby orders:-

### Amendment

1. The Health Service (Medical Appliances) Regulations, 1990, as amended<sup>(b)</sup>, are amended as follows:-

- (a) In Regulation 2(b) after "and" insert "in the case of lancets and urine sugar analysis sets".
- (b) For the First Schedule substitute the Schedule set out in the First Schedule to these Regulations.
- (c) For the Third Schedule substitute the Schedule set out in the Second Schedule to these Regulations.

### Repeal

2. The following regulations are hereby repealed:-

- (a) The Health Service (Medical Appliances) (Amendment) Regulations, 1999<sup>(c)</sup>;
- (b) Regulation 1(b) of The Health Service (Medical Appliances) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1999<sup>(d)</sup>.

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## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations further amend the Health Service (Medical Appliances) Regulations, 1990, as amended, by increasing the charges payable to authorised appliance suppliers in Guernsey and Alderney by persons supplied with Part I, II or III medical appliances who are not exempt from such charges. They also allow for the prescribing of hypodermic needles and syringes for a wider group of people than just those suffering from diabetes and for the prescribing of nebulisers.
