The Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(General)(Amendment)
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1980

Made 30th September, 1980
Laid before the States
Coming into operation 1st November, 1980

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (3) of section twenty-three and subsection (1) of section twenty-eight of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(Guernsey) Law, 1972, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of Second Schedule to the principal regulations

1. Part IV of the Second Schedule to the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(General)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1972 as amended, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") is hereby repealed and the provisions set out in the Schedule to these regulations are hereby substituted therefor.

Repeals

2. The Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(General)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1973 are hereby repealed.

Citation, collective title and commencement

3. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(General)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1980.

(2) These regulations and the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(General)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1972 to 1977 may be cited together as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(General)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1972 to 1980.

(3) These regulations shall come into operation on the first day of November, nineteen hundred and eighty.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

Part IV of the Second Schedule to the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (General)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1972, sets out the chemical reagents which may be supplied under the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(Guernsey) Law, 1972. The purpose of these regulations is to substitute for that Part of that Schedule the list of chemical reagents set out in the Schedule to these regulations; the practical effect of the amendment is to include glycosuria and proteinuria detection strips as a chemical reagent which may be supplied under the Law.
