**The Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) Regulations, 1998**

**THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 11 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended<sup>a</sup>, hereby orders:-

**Amendment**

1. Regulation 34 of the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended<sup>b</sup>, is re-numbered as paragraph (1) and the following paragraphs inserted:

“ (2) A person who has elected not to pay contributions in accordance with paragraph (1) of this regulation shall not be credited with a Class 1 or Class 2 contribution under the provisions of Regulation 12 or 13 of these regulations.

(3) A notice cancelling an election not to be liable to pay contributions shall not come into effect during any period in which, but for the operation of paragraph (2) of this regulation, the person would be entitled to be credited with a Class 1 or Class 2 contribution.”

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations relate to those over age 60 who, being non-employed, have elected not to pay social insurance contributions. Although contributions paid prior to retirement may give entitlement to benefit, these Regulations prevent the award of a contribution credit.
