**THE STATES TRAFFIC COMMITTEE**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 3A(1) of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended (a), hereby orders:-

**Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.**

1. In Part IX of Schedule 1 to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended, the following is inserted in the appropriate place-

"2. Frie au Four, between Rue Fevresse and Rue de la Neuve Maison, except for access to premises therein: This paragraph applies only to vehicles of an overall width in excess of six feet."

**Citation.**

2. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1996.

**Commencement.**

3. This Order shall come into force on 7th October 1996.
