**The Social Insurance (Married Women and Widows) (Amendment)
Regulations, 1995**

Made 29th September, 1995

Laid before the States

Coming into operation 1st January, 1996

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 97 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended(a), hereby orders:-

Amendments

1. In the Social Insurance (Married Women and Widows) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978(b), as amended(c):

- (a) in Regulation 2(2)(c), for "0.5 per centum" is substituted "such percentage rate as the States may, by Ordinance, from time to time prescribe";
- (b) in Regulation 3(1), after "Class 2 contributions", insert ", other than a self-employed married woman's health benefit contribution at such percentage rate as the States may, by Ordinance, from time to time prescribe";
- (c) in Regulation 3(2), the words "either" and "or an election to pay Class 3 contributions" are deleted;
- (d) in Regulation 4(1), after "Class 3 contributions", insert "other than a non-employed health benefit contribution at such percentage rate as the States may, by Ordinance, from time to time prescribe";
- (e) in Regulation 5(2)(c), for "0.5 per centum" is substituted "such percentage rate as the States may, by Ordinance, from time to time prescribe".

Extent

3. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Married Women and Widows) (Amendment) Regulations, 1995.

Commencement

5. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st January, 1996.

These Regulations implement the decision of the States of Deliberation that married women should make a contribution towards health benefits even when otherwise exempted from paying social insurance contributions.
