The Social Insurance (Married Women) (Amendment)  
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1977

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section sixty-five and section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders -

Amendments to principal regulations

1. The Social Insurance (Married Women) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations"), are hereby further amended as follows -

(a) in paragraph (2) of regulation 1A, thereof, the words "nine new pence" are hereby repealed and the words "eleven new pence" are hereby substituted therefor;

(b) in regulation seven thereof, -

(i) there is hereby inserted the following paragraph -

"(3A) Where a woman's marriage has been terminated otherwise than by the death of her husband and she was under pensionable age on the date of that termination, she shall be deemed, for the purposes of regulation four A of the Social Insurance (New Entrants) (Transitional) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, to be a new entrant to whom that regulation applies notwithstanding that she has not paid one hundred and fifty-six contributions of the appropriate class.";

(ii) paragraph (4) is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor -

"(4) The foregoing provisions of this regulation shall not apply in the case of a woman whose marriage has or had been terminated otherwise than by the death of her husband, if, being under pensionable age on the date of that termination, she has, or had, remarried after that termination and before attaining that age.";

(c) in regulation nine thereof. -

(i) immediately before the words "Where a woman is entitled" there are hereby inserted the figure and brackets "(1)";

(ii) immediately after the words "the contribution conditions for an old age pension" there is hereby inserted the following paragraph -

"(2) Where a woman -

(i) is or was entitled to widow's benefit (including widow's basic pension) immediately before she attains or had attained pensionable age; or

(ii) would be or would have been so entitled but for any of the causes specified in paragraph (1) of this regulation;

she shall be deemed, for the purposes of regulation four A of the Social Insurance (New Entrants) (Transitional)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, to be a new entrant to whom that regulation applies notwithstanding that she had not paid one hundred and fifty-six contributions of the appropriate class."


Citation and commencement

2.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Married Women) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1977.

(2) These regulations and the Social Insurance (Married Women) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 to 1974, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Married Woman) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 to 1977.

(3) These regulations shall come into operation on the twenty-first day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations increase the rate of contributions payable by certain married women and deem certain widows and women whose marriage has been terminated by divorce as being persons to whom regulation four A of the Social Insurance (New Entrants) (Transitional) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 shall apply.
