

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY)

(AMENDMENT NO. 10) ORDER 1989

The Board of Administration in pursuance of its powers under Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law 1946 hereby orders:-

1. In the First Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1978 (a) as amended, the following entry shall be inserted after the entry relating to indecent or obscene prints:-

"Ivory and its derivatives".

2. In the Second Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1978 (a) as amended, the following entry shall be deleted:-

"Tobacco and Tobacco Products."

3. This Order may be cited as The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) (Amendment No. 10) Order 1989, and shall come into force on the twentieth day of September, nineteen hundred and eighty-nine.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Amendment Order but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The effect of the Amendment Order is to prohibit the importation from the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey and the Isle of Man, of Ivory and its derivatives except under the authority of an Import Licence, and to allow Tobacco and Tobacco products to be exported to the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey and the Isle of Man, without an Export Licence.
