

THE PROHIBITED AND ONE-WAY STREETS (AMENDMENT) (NO 2) ORDER, 1999

Made16th August 1999

Coming into force23rd August 1999

THE STATES TRAFFIC COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 3A(1) of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended, hereby orders:-

Amendments to 1989 Ordinance.

- 1. In Part VI of Schedule 1 to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended, entry Number 3, relating to Les Hures, Vale, is deleted.
- 2. In Part IX of Schedule 2 to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended, entry Number 6A, relating to Les Hures, Vale, is deleted.

Citation.

- 3. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No 2) Order, 1999.

Commencement.

- 4. This Order shall come into force on 23rd August 1999.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note does not form part of the Order)

The purpose of this Order is to make permanent the experimental repeal of the regulations that scheduled Les Hures as a one-way street, which was also prohibited to all traffic at certain times of day except for access to the former landfill site at Crêve Coeur.
