The Company Documents (Inspection and Copying Fees) Regulations, 1991

Made ... .. 22nd February, 1991

Coming into operation ... 1st April, 1991

THE STATES ADVISORY AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 16(4) of the Companies (Guernsey) Law, 1990(a), hereby makes the following regulations -

Maximum inspection and copying fees

1. The fees prescribed for the purposes of paragraph (a) of section 16(4) of Companies (Guernsey) Law, 1990 are as follows:

- (a) the maximum fee which a company may charge to a person who is not a member or director of the company for inspection of any of the registers, or of the index, referred to in section 16(1) of that Law, is £5;
- (b) the maximum fee which a company may charge to a person requiring a copy of any document open to his inspection pursuant to section 16(3) of that Law is £1 for each page copied in accordance with that requirement.
