The Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) Regulations, 2001

Made 31st January, 2001.

Laid before the States

Coming into operation 1st January, 2001.

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 6 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended^a, and of all the powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. Sub-paragraph (2)(a) of regulation 10 of the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2000^b is repealed and replaced by the following:

“(a) make application to the Authority within such period as the Authority may allow, in such form as may for the time being be approved by the Authority, for the grant of a certificate of assessment under the next following Regulations, such application, once made, being deemed to relate also to future contribution years until notification is received to the contrary; and”
