**The Alderney eGambling (Amendment) (No. 2)
Regulations, 2006**

THE ALDERNEY GAMBLING CONTROL COMMISSION, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 20 and 25 of the Alderney eGambling Ordinance, 2006(a), hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment to 2006 Regulations.

1. In regulation 340(6)(a) of the Alderney eGambling Regulations, 2006, as amended, for “seven days” substitute “at least 24 hours”.

Interpretation.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(b) applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment in force in the Island of Guernsey.

Citation.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Alderney eGambling (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 2006.

Commencement.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 19th December, 2006.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

These Regulations are made by the Alderney Gambling Control Commission under the Alderney eGambling Ordinance, 2006 and reduce the period at which a customer's notification to an eGambling licensee increasing or removing his self-imposed limitation on his gambling activity takes effect from seven days to a minimum of 24 hours.
