

ALDERNEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT 1993 No. 3

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (AMENDMENT)
(ALDERNEY) ORDER, 1993

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY FINANCE COMMITTEE in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article 1 of The Import and Export (Control) (Alderney) Law, 1946, (a) hereby orders:-

1. In Schedule 1 to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Alderney) Order 1992, the following entry shall be inserted after entry 15:

"16. Any decoding equipment which is designed or adapted to be used primarily for the purpose of enabling the reception of programmes transmitted in the provision of a proscribed service within the meaning of Section 178 of the Broadcasting Act 1990".

2. In Schedule 2 to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Alderney) Order 1992, the following entry shall be inserted after entry 1 :

"2. Any decoding equipment which is designed or adapted to be used primarily for the purpose of enabling the reception of programmes transmitted in the provision of a proscribed service within the meaning of Section 178 of the Broadcasting Act 1990".

3. This Order may be cited as the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment) (Alderney) Order, 1993, and shall come into force on the 23rd day of June 1993.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not part of the Amendment Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The effect of the Amendment Order is to prohibit without a Licence the importation from and the exportation to the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey and the Isle of Man, of any decoding equipment enabling reception of proscribed services (e.g. Red Hot Television),
