THE STATES TRAFFIC COMMITTEE, in accordance the powers conferred upon it by section 1(4) of the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) Ordinance, 1974, as amended<sup>(1)</sup>, hereby orders:-

Prescribed fee

1. For the purposes of section 1(4) of the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) Ordinance, 1974, as amended, the fee prescribed for the issue of a driving permit issued under section 1 (1) of that Ordinance shall be five pounds.

Citation.

2. This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) (Driving Permit Fee) Order, 1999.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into force on the first day of October, 1999.
