
GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) (No. 2)
Regulations, 1988.

Made: 27 October, 1988.

Coming into operation: 1 November, 1988.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Vehiculaire en cette Ile" on 2 March, 1929 (a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950 (b), and of all powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating vehicular traffic in this Island:-

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer, drive or ride that vehicle or cause or permit that animal to proceed along the section of the estate road of the Sausmarez Mill ("Old Mill") Housing Estate, St. Martin's, which lies between the junction with the access road to Le Hurel Estate and the junction with Ville Amphrey, otherwise than from east to west.

2. In these Regulations:-

"animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings assigned to them by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Vehiculaire en cette Ile" of 2 March, 1929.

"Chief Officer" means the Chief Officer of the Island Police Force.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-way Streets) (No. 2) Regulations, 1988.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 27 day of October, 1988, and shall continue in force until the 26 day of April, 1989.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note forms no part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

The effect of these Regulations is that from 1 November, 1988, to 26 April, 1989, the estate road of the Sausmarez Mill ("Old Mill") Housing Estate will be a one-way street from its junction with the access road to Le Hurel Estate to its junction with the Ville Amphrey, with traffic being required to travel towards Ville Amphrey only. Two-way traffic will be retained in the section of the road between the Rue de Hurel and the access road to Le Hurel Estate in order that traffic leaving Le Hurel Estate will not be required to travel through the Sausmarez Mill ("Old Mill") Estate.
