The Social Insurance (Classification)(Amendment)
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1987

Made 27th October, 1987

Laid before the States

Coming into operation 1st January, 1988

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 1 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended^(a), hereby orders:-

Amendment of paragraph 8 of the First Schedule to the principal Regulations

1. Part III of the First Schedule to the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended^(b), is hereby amended as follows:-

(a) in paragraph 8(a) of Column (A) thereof the words "eighteen pounds" are repealed and the words "twenty pounds" are substituted therefor;

(b) in paragraph 8(b) of Column (A) thereof the words "seventy-eight pounds" are repealed and the words "eighty-six pounds and sixty-seven pence" are substituted therefor.

Repeal

2. The Social Insurance (Classification) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1986^(c), are hereby repealed.

Extent

3. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Classification) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1987.

Collective Title

5. These Regulations and the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 to 1979, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 to 1987.

Commencement

6. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1988.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations further amend the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, so as to provide that an insured person who is employed under a contract of service from which he derives weekly earnings of less than twenty pounds or monthly earnings of less than eighty-six pounds and sixty-seven pence shall be treated as a non-employed person.
