The Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit)
(Amendment)(No.2)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1981.

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section twenty-three of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of regulation six of the principal regulations

1. In sub-paragraph (g) of paragraph (1) of regulation six of the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended(b), the words "seventy-five pence" are hereby repealed and the words "two pounds" are hereby substituted therefor.

Repeal

2. Paragraph (2) of regulation two of the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1981(c) is hereby repealed.

Citation and collective title

3. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit)(Amendment)(No.2)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1981.

(2) These regulations, the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1981(c), and the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit) Regulations, 1978 and 1979 (d), may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 to 1981.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

Regulation one amends regulation six of the principal regulations so that the daily limit of earnings from subsidiary employment shall be increased from seventy-five pence to two pounds.
